A 135- acre rock quarry located at the Riverside County- San Diego County line - ideal for making concrete and asphalt materials.

Project would provide 40 percent of current aggregate needs for western Riverside County for 75 years.

Need

The Inland Empire will run out of raw material reserves in 17 years if a new source isn't found.
(California Department of Conservation)

Traffic Reductions

Project will remove 1,217 trucks **daily** from Interstate 15, eliminating over 16 million truck- miles **annually**, resulting in less traffic and lower emissions.

Air Quality Improvements

Project will reduce air emissions by over 216 tons annually.

Economic Benefits

\$300 million New sales tax revenue
\$41 million New property taxes and fees
\$2.2 million Riverside County taxes annually
\$6.1 million State of California taxes annually

Will **keep aggregate prices low** by reducing transportation costs.

Jobs

99 on- site high paying jobs and an additional 178 indirect jobs in other parts of Riverside County.

EIR Conclusion: The region is better off with this quarry than without it
